100% Sauvignon Blanc**



Pale lemon colour, almost transparent



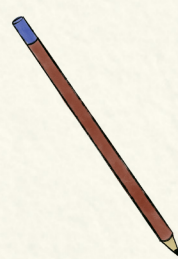
Defined aromas with pronounced intensity

Ripe green fruit (apple, gooseberry), ripe citrus fruit (lemon, lime), ripe stone fruit (peach), ripe tropical fruit (passion fruit, guava), herbaceous (cut grass, asparagus), flowers (acacia, elderflower)



Dry, high acidity, medium alcohol, medium(+) body, long finish

Flavours of pronounced intensity with apple, gooseberry, lemon, peach, passion fruit, guava, cut grass, asparagus, acacia and elderflower



Outstanding wine: luxuriant, refreshing & fragrant

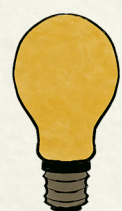
